Bridge to progress in emerging markets

Our journey:

Reuse Trading was established as a chemical trading company in 2015 with the aim of connecting producers worldwide with emerging markets. Africa became our first core region, where we built a strong presence across East, West and Central Africa. North and Southern Africa soon followed. We also expanded our activities by supporting intra-Africa trade, promoting exports and creating long-term partnerships in which clients became suppliers and suppliers became clients.

As our customer base grew, so did the need for our product offering so in 2016 we added a vegetable oils division to our company. In 2018 we handled our first bulk shipment, marking an operational milestone that supported further growth in both chemicals and oils.

In 2020 we extended our activities to Latin America by building a dedicated team serving Central and South America. This step was reinforced by long-standing sourcing relationships and our experience in the products these industries rely on. As our organisation continued to expand, we moved into a larger office in Antwerp in 2023.

In 2025 we launched SOCAMI Industries in Cameroon, a joint initiative with local entrepreneurs aligned with our bridge to progress vision. Drawing on our experience in the palm oil sector, the project evolved into a kernel-crushing plant focused on processing locally sourced palm kernel nuts to support sustainable industrial development and local value creation.

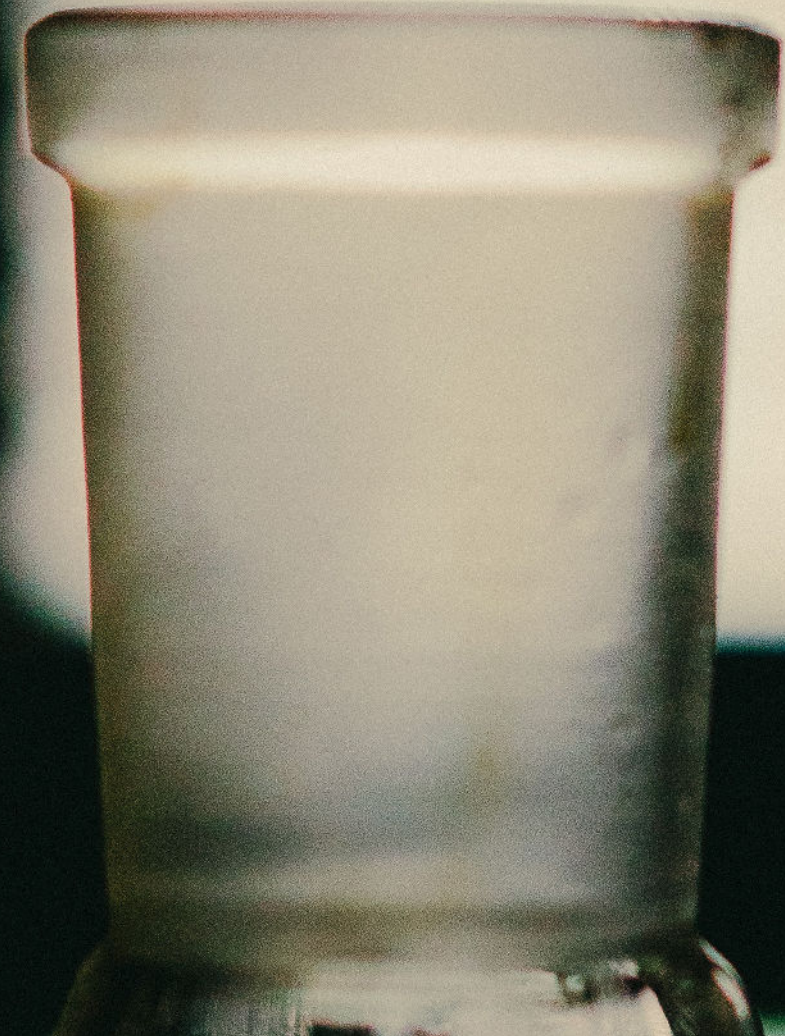

Tropical oils

We supply a broad range of tropical oils sourced from reputable producers in Africa and Latin America. These oils deliver stable functional performance for food, personal-care and industrial applications. Our RSPO certification anchors every sourcing decision in sustainability and traceability, while strict quality controls uphold consistent specifications across all shipments. We are offering these tropical oils both crude and refined.

Vegetable fats

We provide vegetable-based fats that support diverse technical needs, from structured lipids in food production to functional bases in personal-care and industrial formulations. We rely on RSPO-aligned supply chains and rigorous quality evaluation, so customers receive dependable profiles, clean documentation and steady delivery.

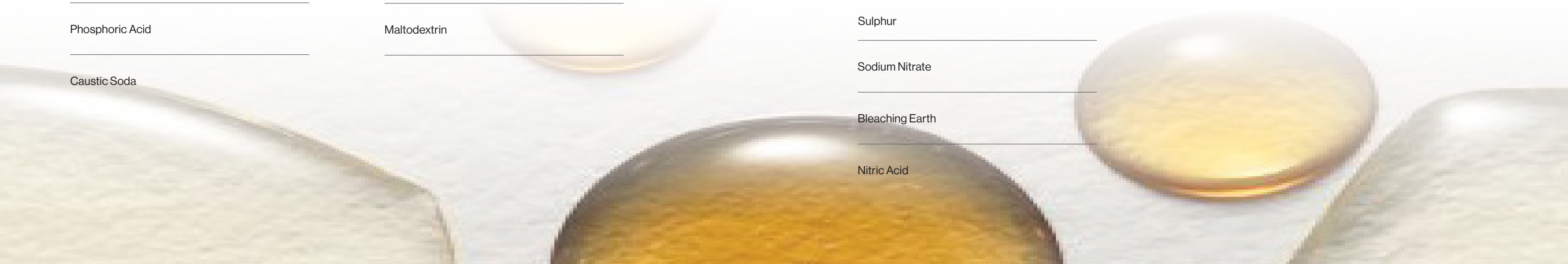
